This information is being provided subsequent to our submission on benzene (EPA Document Control Number 8EHQ-0990-1077). We are continuing to coordinate our activities concerning this matter with local, state, and EPA Region II authorities.

Specific information is provided in response to your request to provide any further significant monitoring information obtained during the investigation into the reported environmental contamination.

Analytical testing of samples taken from groundwater monitoring wells located on company property has detected low levels of chemicals including 1,2-dichloroethane, benzene, methylene chloride, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, vinyl chloride, trichloroethylene, and 1,4-dioxane.

No chemical contamination has been detected in recent samples taken from groundwater monitoring wells located at the company property line. As stated previously in our submission of September 27, 1990, the potential for human exposure to the groundwater is very low. The site is being remediated in coordination with local, state, and federal agencies.
