It is our understanding that the compounds listed, on the Appendix XII Part 268.32, 40 CFR Ch. I (7-1-90) edition and (7-1-92) edition, as 1,2-Dibromomethane and Hexachloroprophene are in actuality 1,2-DibromoETANE and HexachlorPHENE respectively. As this definitely affects the purchase and use of standards and the analysis and reporting of data, the correction of these potential typographic errors is of utmost importance to our laboratory.
