Thank you for your letter regarding the Ecotech Waste Oil Reprocessing System. In the United States, used oil recycling and processing is regulated by the Used Oil Management Standards. I have included a copy of these regulations (40 CFR Part 279) for your convenience.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency does not certify or approve used oil recycling technologies. Some states may require that used oil recycling facilities have permits or other types of approvals. I recommend that you contact any states where you are interested in using your system to determine the specific regulatory requirements.
