

QUESTION: A company has an F002 waste stream (1,1,1-trichloroethane) which it plans to delist according to sections 260.20 and 260.22. What criteria or standards does EPA use in evaluating a delisting petition?

ANSWER: In evaluating a delisting petition, EPA compares concentrations of the hazardous waste in the waste stream (in this case, 1,1,1-trichloroethane) with the applicable water quality criterion for that chemical as established by the Agency's Water Program, or by comparison to a standard listed by the Agency's Carcinogen Assessment Group. For further clarification on the criteria for listing and delisting a hazardous waste, section 261.11 may be consulted.
