Dear Mr. Gabel:

You recently sent us a report prepared by Chemical Waste Management, Inc. (CWM) in accordance with the terms of a RCRA 3008(h) order. The report provides information on waste codes and contains analytical data on wastes which were disposed in several lagoons and landfills at the Model City facility.

Based on CWM's of wastes disposed in the lagoons and landfills, the material, when moved and placed into another land disposal unit, will be subject to the Land Disposal Restrictions for F001 to F005 spent solvents, for a number of First Third wastes for which treatment standards were set and for some First Third wastes for which standards were not set ("soft hammer" wastes). More wastes will be added to those subject to Land Disposal Restrictions in June of 1989, and all pre-HSWA listed and characteristic wastes will be subject to the restrictions by May 8, 1990.

The attached tables list the wastes present in the lagoons and landfills for which standards are now in effect, the effective dates of the standards and the constituent concentrations.

If these wastes are removed and placed in a different land disposal unit after the effective date for the Second Third (June 8, 1989) or Third Third (May 8, 1990) rules, additional waste codes will be affected.
