

QUESTION: When an owner or operator submits his permit application for a hazardous waste management facility (either new or existing) to the Regional Office, does the Regional Office have a specified time limit in which it must review the permit application for completeness?

ANSWER: No, 40CFR 124.3 (c) states that the technical and administrative completeness review of a hazardous waste management facility application should be made in 30 days for new facilities and 60 days for existing facilities. The Agency intends to use this schedule as a management tool and is not bound by these dates.
