We do not have these compounds specified, so the CAS number given for those constituents followed by "N.O.S." refers to the actual compound listed, and not the class.

Dear Mr. Skinner:

The Water Resources Division of the U.S. Geological Survey is prioritizing selected hazardous substances based upon production, acute toxicity, persistence, and bioaccumulation. As part of this effort, we are prioritizing the hazardous substances subject to regulation under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. Specifically, we request that a listing of the name of each identifiable hazardous substance be provided, sorted by Chemical Abstract Service registry number, for the substances given in: Code of Federal Regulations (revised as of July 1, 1984), Title 40, Part 261 (Identification and Listing of Hazardous Waste), Appendix VIII (Hazardous Constituents). We are particularly interested in individual substances which would be included within groups of substances identified in Appendix VIII (such as the substances included under the groups chlorinated benzenes, chlorinated phenol, etc.).
