Thank you for your letter of November 19, 1986, requesting an interpretation of the activities allowed under 40 CFR 262.34.

In your letter, you refer to the preamble discussion in the March 24, 1986 final regulations for small quantity generators which states that no permit would be required if a generator chooses to treat its hazardous waste in a tank or container that is fully in compliance with all of the requirements imposed by §262.34. You are correct in noting that this interpretation applies to all generators subject to §262.34.

Enclosed for your information is a memo which further clarifies the scope and limitations of this interpretation.
