9. Variances to Ban

What are the effective dates for solvents and dioxins under the land disposal restrictions?

The land disposal restrictions become effective on November 3, 1986, for all F001-F005 solvent wastes, with the exception of the following wastes which will receive a 2-year variance that extends the effective date for the land disposal restrictions to November 8, 1988:

- (1) The generator of the solvent waste is a small quantity generator of 100-1000 kilograms of hazardous waste per month; or
- (2) The solvent waste is generated from any response action taken under sections 104 or 106 of CERCLA or any RCRA corrective action, except where the waste is contaminated soil or debris not subject to the provisions of this chapter until November 8, 1988; or
- (3) The solvent waste is a solvent-water mixture, a solvent-containing sludge, or a solvent-contaminated soil (non-CERCLA or RCRA correction action) containing less than 1 percent total F001-F005 solvent constituents listed in Table CCWE of §268.41. (51 FR 40579)

Furthermore, until November 8, 1988, contaminated soil or debris resulting from a response action taken under section 104 or 106 of CERCLA or a corrective action required under RCRA may continue to be land disposed (§268.1(c)(3)).

Finally, effective November 8, 1988, the dioxin-containing wastes specified in 40 CFR 261.31 as EPA Hazardous Waste Nos. F020, F021, F022, F023, F026, F027, and F028, are prohibited from land disposal (§268.31(a)).
