CONSTRUCTION SPECIFICATIONS

DIVISION 01 – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

01063 Safety and Health

Specifies the requirements the contractor needs to follow when developing their construction health and safety program.

01110 Summary of Work

Summarizes the work to be completed for the project.

01150 Archeological and Paleontological Resources

Specifies any archeological requirements to be followed by the contractor during the work.

01270 Measurement and Payment

Specifies how each construction element will be measured and paid.

01310 Project Management and Coordination

Specifies how the project will be managed and coordinated by the contractor.

01320 Construction Progress Documentation

Specifies how the contractor will document progress of their work.

01323 Progress Schedules and Reports

Specifies how requirements and procedures for preparing construction schedules, schedule of values, reports, and fixed asset information.

01330 Submittals Procedure

Specifies the submittal process that the contractor shall follow during construction.

01450 Construction Quality Control

Specifies the contractor's quality control requirements, duties, and responsibilities during execution of the work. Provides requirements for establishing the construction quality control plan to be implemented during construction.

01500 Temporary Facilities and Controls

Specifies the necessary provisions the contractor is required to make for temporary utilities, temporary controls (barriers, fencing, security, etc.) and construction facilities (parking and staging areas, etc.).

01505 Mobilization/Demobilization

Defines what constitutes mobilization and demobilization.

01560 Environmental Protection

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Provides requirements for preventing environmental pollution and minimizing environmental degradation during and as a result of construction operations. Specifies requirements for the contractor to develop and maintain an Environmental Protection Plan during construction.

01573 Temporary Navigational Lights

Specifies that the contractor shall furnish and install temporary navigation lights as required by the United State Coast Guard.

01575 Marker Buoys

Specifies the use of marker buoys by the contractor during the remedial action.

01741 Construction Waste Recycling

This section describes recycling goals for construction and demolition work on Port property.

01770 Contract Closeout

Specifies to the contractor what is required before the project is closed out.

DIVISION 02 – SITE CONSTRUCTION

02050 Demolition

Specifies the demolition work to be completed (structure removal, pile removal, etc.).

02200 Earthwork

Specifies elements related to earthwork (material specifications, placement requirements, etc.).

02269 Trench Safety Systems

Specifies requirements for trenching in deeper excavations.

02360 Piling

Specifies pile installation requirements

02482 Dredging and Disposal

Specifies requirements for dredging and disposal. This will include definitions, tolerances, required BMPs, survey control, operational considerations, etc.

02483 Offshore Capping

Specifies the materials and procedures for placing caps. This will include definitions, tolerances, required BMPs, survey control, operational considerations, etc.
