EPA Has Completed a Checkup on the Tulalip Landfill Cleanup Site in Marysville, Washington

This year, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) completed the second checkup, called a five-year review, of the Tulalip Landfill site. The review identified follow-up work to ensure that the cleanup continues to protect people and the environment. With oversight from EPA, The Tulalip Tribes will take actions, including these:

- Sample soil, mud, and liquid seeping out of the landfill.
- Determine whether water pools on the landfill cover when rain is heavy.
- Determine whether deed notices or restrictions are on file for the entire site.
- Add tribal regulations to enforce these deed restrictions.
