IN THE MATTER OF A VARIANCE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

ORDER GRANTING A VARIANCE

WHEREAS, Colonel Albert K. Mode, USA, Chief of Transportation Management, Division Directorate for Transportation Energy and Troop Support, Department of the Army, has requested a variance to Section 4.100 of the Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution to permit operation of motor vehicles, owned by Department of Defense Personnel, without functioning catalytic converters for a period of time before export and after import in order to prevent the poisoning of the catalyst by use of leaded gasoline overseas;

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this request was conducted on June 14, 1979 at the Hampton Roads Regional Office of the State Air Pollution Control Board, Pembroke IV, Suite 409, Virginia Beach, Virginia.

WHEREAS, at said hearing no one appeared in opposition;

WHEREAS, the Board was of the opinion that granting this variance would not adversely affect the attainment and maintenance of ambient air quality standards;

WHEREAS, upon review of the record and evidence, the Board is of the opinion that the variance should be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that a variance to Section 4.100 (Rule EX-10) of the Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution be granted from January 1, 1980, through December 31, 1982, to a person exporting or importing a catalytic converter equipped, privately owned, motor vehicle with

the catalytic converter removed or inoperative for a period of seven days before export and seven days after import.

It is further ORDERED that the Director of Transportation, Energy and Troop Support, Department of the Army, insure that only certain responsible authenticating personnel issue the following certificate to the persons requiring it.

The State Air Pollution Control Board of the Commonwealth of Virginia has authorized the Director of the Department of Defense, Consolidated Personal Property Shipping Office, Naval Supply Center, Norfolk, Virginia to certify that the bearer may operate his privately owned export/import motor vehicle for seven days before or seven days after the date indicated below without properly installed emission control equipment. This is a variance to the Virginia State Air Pollution Control Board's Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution, Section 4.100 (Rule EX-10).


