Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permits to
Pactuco, Inc., Midwest Division,
Textron Automotive Company – Rantoul Products Plant No. 1,
Textron Automotive Company – Rantoul Products Plant No. 2, and
Textron Automotive Company – Rantoul Products Plant No. 3,

The above listed companies have requested Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permits from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for air emissions from their facilities in Rantoul. Pactuco, Inc., Midwest Division is a manufacturer of plastic foam products located at 1924-B, CR 3000 North Route 136 East. The three Textron facilities manufacture interior parts and accessories for motor vehicles. The Textron facilities are located at 300 Shelhouse Drive, 707 Veterans Parkway, and 735 Pacesetter Drive. The CAAPP permits are federal operating permits for existing operations at the facilities. The permits will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. The permits may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making them combined CAAPP and Title I permits. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permits.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permits. Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 8, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
