Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit to
Page Two, Inc., Bartonville

Page Two, Inc. has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its aluminum coated steel wire manufacturing facility located at 7000 SW Adams in Bartonville. Currently, Page Two, Inc. is operating pursuant to state operating permits. The CAAPP permit will supersede the state operating permits. Unlike the state operating permits, the CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Persons wanting more information may review the Illinois EPA's project summary and draft permit and the permit application at the Illinois EPA's offices at 5415 North University in Peoria, and 1340 North Ninth St., Springfield. Copies of the documents will be made available upon request.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 6, 1997. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
