of a Proposed Renewal of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for
Daily Southtown, Inc., Chicago

Daily Southtown, Inc. has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its newspaper printing operations located at 5959 South Harlem Avenue in Chicago. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
