Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Village of Freeburg Power Plant

The Village of Freeburg Power Plant has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to install three new diesel engines at its facility located at the North Substation Power Plant at the intersection of Power Plant Road and Peabody Road in Freeburg. This construction permit will supersede a previous construction permit issued to the facility to construct four diesel engines which were not constructed. This project would not result in a major increase in emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or state rules 35 IAC 203: Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification (MSSCAM).

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 29, 2005. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
