Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Renewable Power of Wayne City, LLC

Renewable Power of Wayne City, LLC, 10200 Mohawk, Leawood, Kansas, has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct an ethanol manufacturing plant to be located southwest of the intersection of IL Route 15 and CR 500E near Wayne City. The project would have the capacity to produce up to 92.8 million gallons of ethanol a year. The project would not be a major new source of air emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or state rules 35 IAC 203: Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification (MSSCAM).

Based on its review of Renewable Power's application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit. **The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 29, 2006.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
