Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit to
Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America, Geneseo

Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a construction permit for an engine at its facility located at 16648 Illinois Highway 82 in Geneseo. The company is installing high-pressure fuel injection to the engine. The engine is used to provide power to the natural gas compressor units. The modification of the engine would not constitute a major new source of air emissions pursuant to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 18, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
