Notice of Comment Period and Public Hearing
Concerning the Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
to Illini Bio-Energy, LLC in Hartsburg

Illini Bio-Energy, LLC, 3600 Wabash Avenue, Suite C, Springfield, Illinois, 62711, has submitted an application to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) Division of Air Pollution Control for a permit to construct an ethanol plant to be located at 800th Avenue, 1/2 miles north of 2300th Street in Hartsburg. The project would have the capacity to produce up to 110 million gallons of denatured ethanol a year. The Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination to issue a permit for the project and has prepared a draft permit for review. The Illinois EPA is holding a public comment period and a hearing to accept comments from the public on the proposed issuance of a permit for this project, prior to making a final decision on the application. The project would not be considered a major new source under the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21

The Illinois EPA Bureau of Air will hold a public hearing on November 15, 2006 at 7:00 pm at the Hartsburg High School, 400 West Front Street in Hartsburg. The hearing will be held to receive comments and answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the application. The hearing will be held under the Illinois EPA's "Procedures for Permit and Closure Plans," 35 IAC 166, Subpart A. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted in writing. Requests for interpreters (including sign language) must be made by November 1, 2006. Written comments must sent to the Hearing Officer and be postmarked by midnight, December 15, 2006, unless otherwise specified by the Hearing Officer. Written comments need not be notarized.
