Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit to  
the City of Springfield (CWLP)

The City of Springfield has requested Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permits from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for air emissions from its natural gas turbines located at the intersection of 10<sup>th</sup> and Reynolds Streets, and at the intersection of Factory and Griffith Streets in Springfield. Major sources of air emissions are required by the 1990 Amendments to the Clean Air Act to obtain Title V permits. The permits will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permits may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making them combined Title V and Title I permits. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permits.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permits. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 24, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
