Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Alternative Energy Sources, Inc. in Greenville

Alternative Energy Sources, Inc., Post Office Box 410251, Kansas City, Missouri, 64141-0251, has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct an ethanol manufacturing plant to be located at U.S. Route 40 at BNSF Railroad and County Road 140 in Greenville. The project would have a nominal design capacity of 126 million gallons per year of denatured ethanol and would use natural gas as fuel. The project would not be a major new source of air emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight July 14, 2007.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
