Proposed Issuance of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit to
Illinois Valley Paving Company, Elwin

Illinois Valley Paving Company has requested a federally enforceable state operating permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for its asphalt plant located on Route 51 South in Elwin. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance of the permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
