Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Revision of the Construction Permit to
Material Sciences Corporation in Elk Grove Village

Material Sciences Corporation has applied to the Illinois EPA to revise construction permit #95030105 for the coil coating lines at its facility located at 2300 East Pratt Boulevard in Elk Grove Village. The permit is being revised to adjust the offset demonstration in the original permit such that emissions from coil coating lines 2 and 4 may be increased. Under the revision all offsets for coil coat line 18 will come from the shutdown of coil coat line 3. The original construction permit was subject to New Source Review and thus offsets were required. The increases to lines 2 and 4 would not be a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or the state rules Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC Part 203.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 27, 2009.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
