of Proposed Issuance of Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits (FESOP) to
Tenex Corporation, Elk Grove Village, and
Proposed Renewal of Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits to

Smurfit Laminations, Elk Grove Village, and
Coronado Paint Company, Elk Grove Village

Tenex Corporation has requested that the Illinois EPA issue federally enforceable state operating permits (FESOP) to its plastic product manufacturing facilities located at 1810 – 1850 East Estes Avenue and 2400 Arthur Avenue in Elk Grove Village. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Marconi Data Systems, Inc., has requested that the Illinois EPA renew its federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its ink manufacturing facility located at 1855 Estes Avenue in Elk Grove Village. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Smurfit Laminations has requested that the Illinois EPA renew its federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its printing and laminating operations located at 850 Lunt Avenue in Elk Grove Village. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Coronado Paint Company has requested that the Illinois EPA renew its federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its paint manufacturing facility located at 2250 Arthur Avenue in Elk Grove Village. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
