Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit to  
Field Container Company, Elk Grove Village

Field Container Company has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct new gluers and printing presses at its facility located at 1500 Nicholas Boulevard in Elk Grove Village. The facility would also be removing three printing presses and two gluers. The reduction in emissions from the equipment to be removed would offset the increase in emissions from the new equipment so that overall emission increases will not be significant. The project will not be subject to federal "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" (40 CFR 52.21) or state "Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification" (35 IAC Part 203) rules. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight August 21, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
