Notice of Public Comment Period
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
Rowe Foundry, Inc. in Martinsville

Rowe Foundry, Inc. has applied to the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air for a permit to construct a two new paint booths at its facility located at 147 West Cumberland Street in Martinsville. The paint booths will be used to apply coatings to metal castings manufactured at the facility. Emissions from the paint booths will be controlled by filters. The project is not a major new project or modification for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight February 16, 2014.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing or other informational meeting may be held.
