Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to  
Kankakee Renewable Energy, LLC in Kankakee

Kankakee Renewable Energy, LLC, 207 South Fox Run Drive, Mahomet, Illinois 61853, has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct an ethanol manufacturing plant to be located on the southwest corner of the intersection of County Highway 58 and State Highway 115 in Kankakee. The project would have the capacity to produce up to 113.7 million gallons per year of denatured ethanol and would use natural gas as fuel. The project would not be a major new source of air emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 2, 2007.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
