Proposed Issuance of a Joint State Construction and Operating Permit to
Meyercord Revenue Company, Carol Stream

Meyercord Revenue Company has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to construct and operate a tax stamp printing and print pad manufacturing facility at 475 Village Drive and 475 North Gary Avenues in Carol Stream. The permit will limit emissions from the facility to less than major source thresholds therefore this modification is not subject to the Major Stationary Sources Construction And Modification rules (35 IAC 203), or the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules (40 CFR 52.21). The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 30, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
