Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
ITT Bell & Gossett in Morton Grove

ITT Bell & Gossett has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a construction permit to build a wastewater evaporator at its facility at 4200 North Austin Avenue in Morton Grove. The project includes limitation, which prevent it from being subject to 35 IAC Part 203: Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM). The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 19, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
