Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction to  
Berlin Industries, Carol Stream

Berlin Industries has requested a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to install a two new printing lines and modify an existing printing line at its facility located at 175 Mercedes Drive in Carol Stream. The new and modified lines will not be a significant increase in emissions. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 27, 1999. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
