Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit
to Sun Chemical in Northlake

Sun Chemical has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to add two new mixing tanks, two mixers and four vertical shot mills at the facility at 135 West Lake Street in Northlake. The draft permit contains conditions that would prevent the new construction from being a major modification as defined by the state's rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC 203 or the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 29, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
