Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Tate & Lyle Ingredients Americas, Inc. in Decatur

Tate & Lyle Ingredients Americas, Inc. has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct two new boilers (#3 and #4) at its facility located at 2200 East Eldorado Street in Decatur. The new boilers would be permitted to fire primarily natural gas with distillate fuel oil as a backup. The two boilers would replace two existing boilers. The new boilers would be a source of air emissions, however, with the shutdown of the two existing boilers the project would not be a major source of air emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 6, 2007.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
