Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit to
Glen-Gery Corporation - Marseilles

Glen-Gery Corporation has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to modify the permitted air emission limits at its brick manufacturing plant located at 1401 Broadway Street in Marseilles. The draft permit does not involve any new construction but instead would allow an increase in operations from the two kilns and therefore an increase in air emissions. The draft permit contains limitations that would prevent the new construction from being a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 21, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
