Proposed Revision of the Construction Permit/PSD Approval for  
Dynergy Kendall Energy, LLC in Minooka

Dynergy Kendall Energy, LLC has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to revise the construction permit for this existing natural gas fired electric power plant located at 1401 County Line Road in Minooka. Dynergy Kendall Energy is the new owner of this plant, which was originally constructed by LSP-Kendall Energy. Dynergy Kendall Energy has requested changes to the provisions of the permit to address periodic tuning of the combustion turbines, including changes to the provisions that establish Best Available Control Technology. Dynergy Kendall Energy also has requested changes to clarify that operation of a combustion turbine with the duct burners or with the duct burners and steam augmentation is considered separate mode of operation, with associated startups and shutdowns. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that a revised permit would still comply with all applicable Illinois Air Pollution Board Regulations and the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality Regulations (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight July 7, 2007.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
