Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
to Pechiney Plastic Packaging, Batavia

Pechiney Plastic Packaging has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to rebuild one of its printing presses and add a new oxidizer to control emissions from existing printing presses and a parts washer at the facility located at 475 North Kirk Road in Batavia. The permit is required because the printing press will be a source of air emissions. The project is not subject to the requirements of the state Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification rules, 35 IAC 203, or the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is seeking comments on the proposed construction permit.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 9, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
