Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit to
Amoco Pipeline Company – Manhattan Station

Amoco Pipeline Company has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its pipe line breakout station located at 15600 Bruns Road in Manhattan. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 18, 1999. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
