Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Sun Chemical in Kankakee

Sun Chemical, 135 West Lake Street, Northlake, Illinois, 60164, has applied to the Illinois EPA for a construction permit to modify its existing ink production equipment to increase production at its plant located at 3200 Festival Drive in Kankakee. The resulting increase in air emissions would make the plant a major source of emissions for hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) which makes the plant subject to the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants: Miscellaneous Coatings Manufacturing, 40 CFR 63 Subpart HHHHH. The project would not be a major new source or modification for criteria air pollutants as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or the state rules Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC Part 203.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight September 3, 2009.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
