Proposed Issuance of a Prevention of Significant Deterioration Construction
Permit to
KIK Custom Products, Inc. in Danville

KIK Custom Products, Inc. has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to install three new aerosol can filling lines and supporting equipment to its facility located at 1 West Hegeler Lane in Danville. The facility prepares and packages liquid and aerosol personal care and household cleaning products.

The proposed project qualifies as a major modification under the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21, for emissions of volatile organic material (VOM). Under the PSD rules, KIK Custom Products must use Best Available Control Technology (BACT) for control of VOM emissions from the new equipment. VOM emissions will be controlled by the use of through the valve (TTV) filling method or under the cup (UTC) filling method when TTV cannot be utilized. Also, emissions of VOM shall not exceed 0.001 lb of VOM per can filled for the affected units.

Based on its review of the permit application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit. **The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 2, 2005.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
