Notice of Public Comment Period for the  
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to  
Bunge North America, Inc. in Danville

Bunge North America, Inc. has applied to the Illinois EPA for a construction permit for certain changes to the emission units at its grain processing facility located at 321 E. North Street in Danville. First, it is proposing to install two boilers, which would replace existing boilers at the facility. Second, it is proposing to use an existing soybean meal rail loadout to handle hominy and grain. The project would not be a major new source or modification for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 22, 2010.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
