Proposed Issuance of Air Pollution Control Permits to
ITW Chronomatic, Chicago

ITW Chronomatic has requested a federally enforceable state operating permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for its screen printed circuit board manufacturing facility located at 4126 North Nashville Avenue in Chicago. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance of the permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 18, 1999. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
