Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
ExxonMobil Corporation in Arlington Heights

ExxonMobil Corporation has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to modify the facility to increase petroleum product throughput rates for storage tanks and a loading rack at the facility located at 2312 Terminal Drive in Arlington Heights. Increases in air emissions would be less than major source significance thresholds so that this project is not subject the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or 35 IAC 203: Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 7, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
