Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permits to
Georgia-Pacific Tissue, LLC, Alsip and
JLM Chemicals, Inc., Alsip

Georgia-Pacific Tissue has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its recycled paper tissue manufacturing facility located at 13101 South Pulaski Road in Alsip. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making it a combined CAAPP and Title I permit.

JLM Chemicals, Inc., has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its synthetic organic chemicals manufacturing facility located at 3350 West 131st Street in Alsip. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making it a combined CAAPP and Title I permit.
