of the Proposed Revision of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) to
Sun Process Converting, Inc., Mount Prospect

Sun Process Converting, Inc. has requested that the Illinois EPA revise the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its facility located at 1660 Kenneth Drive in Mount Prospect. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed revision. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
