Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction Permit
to Outboard Marine Corporation, Waukegan

Outboard Marine Corporation has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct four new dynamometers at its facility located at 300 Sea-Horse Drive in Waukegan. This facility would not be a major new source of air emissions pursuant to the "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" (40 CFR 52.21) or "Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification" (35 IAC Part 203) rules. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight February 18, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
