of the Proposed Issuance of an Operating Permit
to
D & L Landfill, Inc. in Greenville

D & L Landfill, Inc. has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency issue an operating permit regulating the air emissions from the passive gas flare at the closed portion of the landfill at 825 West Willard Street in Greenville. The Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that the application would comply with the environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 12, 2008. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
