

**Public Notice**  
**Proposed Issuance of a Clean Air Act Permit Program permit**  
**and Notice of Public Hearing for**  
**City of Chicago, Department of Aviation**

The City of Chicago, Department of Aviation has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its operations at O'Hare International Airport. The permit is required pursuant to the federal Clean Air Act for the stationary air emission units operated by the city. These units include heating and hot water boilers, generators, and storage tanks. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

The Illinois EPA will hold a public hearing on Thursday, May 3, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. at the Maine East High School Gymnasium, 2601 West Dempster in Park Ridge. The hearing will be held by the Illinois EPA to receive comments and data and to answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the permit. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted to the Illinois EPA in writing. Written comments must be postmarked by midnight, June 3, 2001, unless otherwise specified by the hearing officer at the time of the hearing. Comments need not be notarized and should be sent to the Illinois EPA Hearing Officer, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.
