Proposed Issuance of a revision to
the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits for
Truman L. Flatt and Sons, Company in Buckhart and Springfield

Truman L. Flatt and Sons, Company has requested revisions to its federally enforceable state operating permits for its asphalt plants located at 2300 North 16th Street in Springfield and Young Road in Buckhart. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed revisions to the permits. The permits contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permits will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
