Proposed Issuance of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for
TransMontaigne Terminaling, Inc., South Rome

TransMontaigne Terminaling, Inc., has requested that the Illinois EPA issue a federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its bulk products terminal located 1000 feet south of Hart Lane on Illinois Route 29 in South Rome. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
