Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to  
S & C Electric Company in Chicago

S & C Electric Company has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to modify its existing Fuse Coating and Marking Line and its Adhesive Application Operation at its facility located at 6601 North Ridge Boulevard in Chicago. The modification would entail an increase in volatile organic material (VOM) emissions and allow the company to discontinue the use of the existing afterburner for control of VOM emissions when low-VOM coatings are used. This project as proposed does not constitute a major modification, i.e., a significant increase in air emissions, as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or the state rules 35 IAC 203: Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this application.
