Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Fabri-Glass Composites, Inc. in Moline

Fabri-Glass Composites, Inc. has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to increase production at its polystyrene molding plant located at 4900 Seventh Street in Moline. Fabri-Glass Composites has proposed to restrict its production rate to limit styrene emissions to less than 10 tons per year to prevent the source from being a major source subject to Section 112(g) of the Clean Air Act. The project also would not be a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 26, 2006.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
